Note: Following a thorough review of their highway network, in line with Government issued guidance, Denbighshire County Council has identified five locations where exceptions Orders to the default speed limit can be safely made, reflecting local needs and considerations and to allow free flow of traffic by retaining the current 30mph speed limits.

This consultation is only for proposed exemptions to the default 20mph speed limit which will come into effect across Wales from 17th September. The effect of these exemptions will be to retain the existing 30mph speed limit in the five locations listed.
