

## **Glan Elwy Community Nature Space**

### **Drawing Description for the Blind**

The proposed Community Nature Space is in the field immediately south of the 'New Inn' public house in St Asaph, between the Lower Denbigh Road and the River Elwy. Access would be from the existing riverside footpath.

The existing hedge and woodland alongside the river would be enhanced by planting more trees. Two woodland viewing platforms would be constructed and signs with information about the site would be installed at each end of the footpath.

The main part of the field would be used for the creation of a wildflower meadow with wetlands in the centre. This central part of the field would be fenced off from public access. However, there would be circulation space around the perimeter, partly to keep clear access for Natural Resources Wales to maintain the flood wall alongside the road. Benches would be provided in the perimeter strip to allow visitors to sit and enjoy the Community Nature Space.

At the southern end of the site, a small woodland would be created. This area would be fenced to protect the trees from deer. Throughout the site, some specimen tree standards of willow, alder, oak, birch and rowan would be planted.
