

# Clocaenog Community Nature Space

## Drawing Description for the Blind

The proposed Community Nature Space is in the former grounds of the old school. There would be two access points. The first would be from the lane on the Ruthin side of the old school building, alongside the road bridge over the Nant y Cefn stream. The second would be from the Community Recreation Ground.

At the end of the site nearest Ruthin, an existing peripheral woodland would be enhanced by planting some additional trees. A wildflower meadow would be created in its central glade and some benches provided to allow visitors to sit and enjoy the Community Nature Space.

At the end of the site nearest Clawddnewydd, where the school playground used to be, some additional seating would be provided – potentially including some logs for groups of schoolchildren. A small pond would be created and a new hedgerow planted along the uphill boundary with adjacent farmland.
