

Henllan Community Nature Space

Drawing Description for the Blind

The proposed Community Nature Space is in the field behind Ffordd Bryn y Garn on the northern edge of the village. Access would be through the existing gateway from the road to Trefnant, which would be enhanced, including an extension of the footway from Ffordd Bryn y Garn.

Trees would be planted in the area of the field closest to the access gate to allow nature connectivity with the woods across the road. A woodland glade would be included. Trees would also be planted to create a new hedgerow along the boundary at the back of the houses to protect privacy.

Wildflower meadows would be created in the main central part of the field, with a pond, a bee bank, owl posts and an outdoor classroom enhancing biodiversity and educational opportunities. At the far end of the field some more formal areas for recreation and picnicking would also be provided.

Circulation through the site would be catered for by both formal and informal pathways. Benches would be installed to allow visitors to sit and enjoy the Community Nature Space. Throughout the site, some individual specimen tree standards would be planted.
