

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING
DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LOGGERHEADS AND MOEL FAMAU COUNTRY PARKS AND LLANGOLLEN)
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
ORDER 2024

At present, parking at Loggerheads Country Park and Bwlch Pen Barras (Moel Famau), and Llantysilio Green, Llangollen) car parks is unregulated other than by charging for use of the parking place when they are open. This often causes hazards and/or obstructions on site and there is evidence of misuse of the car parks.

In particular Denbighshire Countryside Services have raised concerns regarding this obstructive parking at Loggerheads Country Park and Bwlch Pen Barras car parks. The same issues are prevalent at Llantysilio Green car park.

Officer observations have verified the problem.

The current legislation covering the car parks makes it unviable for the Council to enforce these areas and reduces maintenance expenditure to a bare minimum. This proposal is to bring the car parks in to the Civil Parking Enforcement system of control.

Wenffrwd car park is a new car park and it clear from officer observations on usage so far that, although it is free to park in this car park, there is a need to better manage, regulate and control the manner in which vehicles park within this car park.

It appears to the County Council as Order making Authority, that it is necessary and expedient to make this Order in the interests of providing proper controls to the car parks in the Order and to be able to enforce the areas as necessary.
