- Powers to stop people who have been asked to disperse from returning to the restricted area for a period of up to 48 hours
- To ban people from drinking in the street
- Powers to require people to surrender alcohol in their possession if it is being consumed in the street, or it is likely to be consumed in the street

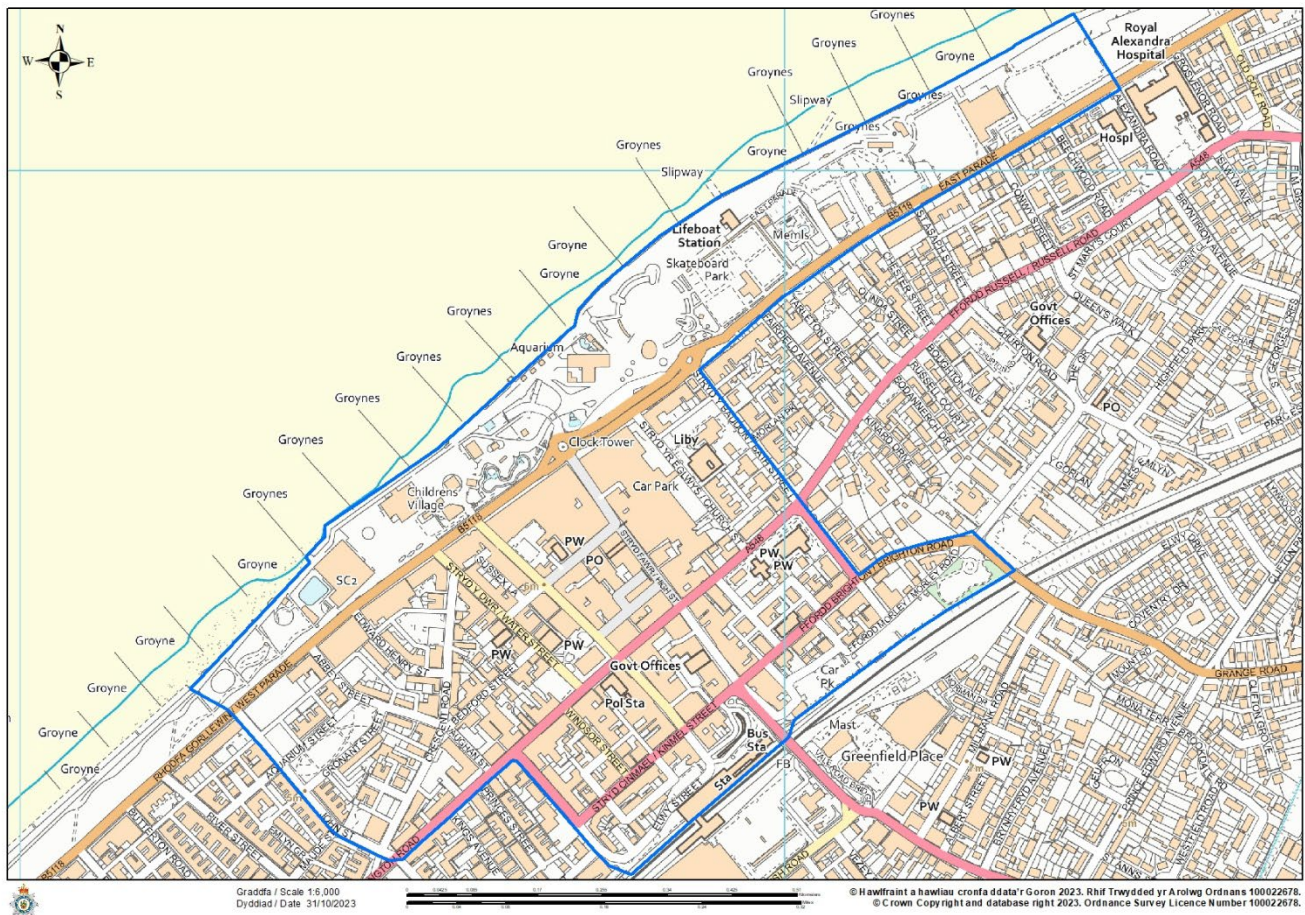

The boundaries are described as follows:

- Rhyl Promenade from East Parade to Alexandra Road
- South from East Parade down Bath Street
- From Brighton Road to the junction with Grange Road Bridge and west to Elwy Street
- Elwy Street to the junction with Wellington Road
- Wellington Road to John Street
- John Street to West Parade, including the promenade
